

- Weather:** Like most tropical climates, Port Douglas has two distinct seasons – a winter period of balmy temperatures and low rainfall, and a summer period of warmer temperatures and tropical evening showers. Winter, or the ‘dry’ season as locals call it, typically begins in May and ends in October and usually means idyllic weather – sunshine, fresh breezes and not too much humidity.
- Pet Policy:** Pets are not allowed at any Wyndham Vacation Resorts Asia Pacific or WorldMark South Pacific Club by Wyndham resort property, except in the case of hearing, mobility or vision-impaired guests.

Things to see and do in Port Douglas

A one hour drive from Cairns Airport, you'll discover that Port Douglas is a must-see, must stay destination. Ramada Port Douglas is the perfect base to experience Mossman Gorge, the Daintree Rainforest, the Great Barrier Reef and the many attractions, tours and activities the region has to offer. Spacious, stylish rooms, an onsite restaurant, great beach access and modern resort facilities make Ramada Port Douglas the perfect choice for a Tropical North Queensland getaway.

Local Attractions

For your convenience, all tours and airport transfers can be organised through Reception.

The Great Barrier Reef: Port Douglas is the closest access point for those wanting to experience the wonders of the Great Barrier Reef. The amazing array of marine wildlife and exotic colours cannot be found anywhere else in the world. Beautiful reefs, exotic fish, clear warm water and the hot sun. Choose from reef cruises in stunning sailboats or luxury yachts, to wave-piercing catamarans operated by Quicksilver. Snorkel, scuba dive or experience the brilliance of the Great Barrier Reef from the comfort of Quicksilver's unique underwater viewing platform.

Cape Tribulation: There is a fully sealed road to Cape Tribulation where rainforest-clad mountains sweep down to greet long sandy beaches. You can experience the many walking tracks and take guided tours by day and night, fly through the rainforest canopy on flying fox zip lines and much more.

The Sunday Markets: Held right on the waterfront overlooking the Coral Sea, the Sunday Markets are a delightful way to spend a morning. The markets are a "Cotters Market", meaning that goods offered for sale are made by the stallholder. Held every Sunday from 8am to 1.30pm at Anzac Park at the end of Macrossan Street, these colourful markets are a wonderful mix of local arts and crafts, souvenirs and fresh produce. Stallholders come from all over the Far North to sell their products including arts and crafts, jewellery, pottery, tropical clothing, fruit and vegetables, glassware, books, homemade foods, unique Australian products, souvenirs and more.

Mossman Gorge, Daintree National Park: Estimated at 60,000 years old, the oldest living rainforest on earth, the Daintree National Park is a sight to behold. Located 20 minutes north of Port Douglas at Mossman Gorge, the crystal clear waters of the Mossman River cascade over granite boulders in a spectacular and serene display of nature's artistry.

Adventure Activities: Port Douglas is known for all its crazy adventure activities such as: diving, snorkelling, glass bottom boat coral viewing, horse riding, water sports, river cruises, white water rafting, hot air ballooning, quad bike riding and bungee jumping.

Dining Out: Enjoy relaxed dining with a rainforest backdrop at the onsite restaurant Tree Bar and Grill. Outside of the resort Port Douglas has some very talented chefs who are renowned for creating innovative and mouth-watering cuisine. There are plenty of diverse eating venues all around the town, from restaurants to cafés and bars.

Directions to Ramada Resort Port Douglas from:

Cairns Airport/South: Head south towards Mick Borzi Drive and turn right. As you go through the roundabout, Mick Borzi Drive veers left and becomes Airport Avenue. Turn right onto Captain Cook Highway/National Route 1 and follow signs to Mareeba/Mossman/Port Douglas and Tourist Drive 14/Captain Cook Highway and go through three roundabouts. On the last roundabout take the second exit onto Captain Cook Highway. Go through four roundabouts and then turn right onto Port Douglas Road and travel through another two roundabouts. Ramada Resort Port Douglas will be on the right. Please note there is no Wyndham Vacation Resorts Asia Pacific signage, the sign will instead read Ramada Resort Port Douglas.
