## Local Attractions

**Hunter Valley Wine Tasting:** With over 100 wineries offering some of the finest vintages in the world, the Hunter Valley is a wine connoisseur's paradise. There are many tours to choose from including small or large tour groups, horse drawn carriage tours or a tour with a difference in a limousine or Cadillac.

**Hunter Valley Hot Air Ballooning:** Hot air ballooning is a pursuit like no other. It's serene and peaceful, but at the same time fun, exciting and utterly addictive! Whether you're a single, a couple or a group, each and every champagne balloon flight makes for an unforgettable and breathtaking aerial adventure.

**Hunter Valley Gardens:** Winner of Best Significant Tourist Attraction in NSW for 2004, 2005 and 2006, plus hall of Fame for 2007. The Hunter Valley Gardens cover over 60 acres. Along the eight kilometres of walking paths are more than 6,000 trees, one million ground covers and 600,000 shrubs. A floral display featuring a variety of plants and statuary at a standard that you won't see elsewhere in Australia. From the main entrance, the visitor will enter through many feature gardens full of breathtaking surprises.

**Barrington Tops National Park:** This beautiful, rugged park is full of contrasts. In the lower valleys, you'll find World Heritage-listed subtropical rainforests. Up on the plateau, there are sub alpine woodlands, which regularly see snow in winter.

## Directions to Pokolbin Hill from:

**Directions from Sydney Airport:** After exiting the terminal, travel along Southern Cross Drive and Eastern Distributor (toll applies) towards the city and take the Sydney Harbour Tunnel to the Gore Hill Freeway. Follow the signs to Hornsby/Newcastle until you reach the F3 Freeway. Travel approximately 100km on the freeway and exit at the Cessnock/Kurri Kurri exit, Freemans Drive and follow this road towards Cessnock (refer to directions below).

**Directions from south on Pacific Highway:** Take the Palmers Road exit, turn right and follow Palmers Road until Freemans Drive, turn right and follow the directions below. Travel approximately 25km towards Cessnock then turn right at the first set of traffic lights into Vincent Street. Travel to the end of Vincent Street and turn left, then immediately turn right at the next set of traffic lights. Travel approximately 10km and take the first left hand turn after the Visitors Centre onto Broke Road. Travel along Broke Road to the very first T Junction then turn right onto McDonalds Road. WorldMark Resort Pokolbin Hill is located on the left.

Please note there is no WorldMark South Pacific Club signage, the sign will instead read "Leisure Inn Pokolbin Hill".
